We also have through our bank a letter of irrevocable line of credit to help with our bonding capacity as well. It is our desire to partner with the state and federal government agencies and on construction projects as our means to provide for our staff and families.

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- How did Aim High Construction come to be:
- I started this company out of a necessity, not because I wanted to. I was a manufacturer's rep for the largest roofing manufacturer in the world. I was doing quite well monetarily; my family was very comfortable. Then it all crashed. My wife called when I was on a business trip in New York and told me to come home and that she got lost trying to go home with our two young daughters after school one day. My wife had MS, and with it won the lottery (a 3% chance to get dementia and she got it). I wrote my resignation letter that night, booked a flight home for the first flight out. I started Aim High Construction. I emptied my savings and my 401K. One of my best friends quit his job to come work for me to get us off the ground and to help my family. My daughters at the time were 7 and 9. I knew if I started a company and had the right people involved, I knew that I could spend more time with my family. I lost my wife in 2019 to her disease and I have raised my daughters basically by myself since they were 7 and 9, along with taking care of my wife until she was protectively placed in a nursing facility in 2017. My daughters are now 18 and 20 and enrolled in college. I started a general contracting company, because I did not want to focus on one attribute or another, I wanted to be well rounded and diverse. We struggled, but we made it. Now a striving business focused on Federal, State and Local Government entities. With many relationships built through the years with our trade partners we are able to tackle any project you throw at us.
- As an Air Force veteran, I am driven to Aim High, hence our companies name and United States Air Force slogan. I have, I am, and I will meet your expectations. I wrestled for the United States Air Force Team in Europe in the early nineteen nineties. I was one match away from making the Olympic Trials in 1992. I say this letting you know that I have drive, dedication and the will to succeed. After that season, I was in a bad vehicle accident while on duty during the first gulf war. I lost a kidney and have severe chronic spinal stenosis in my neck. That is how I became a service-disabled veteran. The Veterans Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development Act of 1999 (Public Law 106-50) established an annual government-wide goal of not less than 3% of the total value of all prime contract and subcontract awards for participation by small business concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans. On December 16, 2003, the Veterans Benefits Act of 2003 (Public Law 108-183) was passed by Congress. Section 308 of the Act (Public Law 108-183) established a procurement program for Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Concerns (SDVOSBC). This procurement program provides that federal contracting officers may restrict competition to SDVOSBCs and award a sole source or set-aside contract where certain criteria are met. The Small Business Administration has issued an interim final rule, establishing a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Concern Program. This program establishes the criteria to be used in federal contracting to determine service-disabled veteran status; business ownership and control requirements; guidelines for establishing sole source and set-aside procurement opportunities; and protest and appeal procedures for SDVOSBC procurements. Purpose of the SDVOSBC Program The purpose of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Concern Procurement Program is to provide procuring agencies with the authority to set acquisitions aside for exclusive competition among service-disabled veteran-owned small business concerns, as well as the authority to make sole source awards to service-disabled veteran-owned small business concerns if certain conditions are met. (See Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 13 C.F.R. § 125.8-125.10).
