The new business description of your company will be:

General contractor firm providing the manufacture and installation of roofing, sheet metal and sheet metal panel systems and steep slope, awnings, balconies, curtain walls, deck and grates, stairways, storefronts, metal frames, and custom stainless-steel fabrication.

In order to remain certified under 49 C.F.R. Part 26, you must contact our office if any significant changes occur in your firm. This includes changes in any of the following: address, work areas the firm performs, locations that the work is conducted and ownership of the firm.

Federal regulations require that in order to remain qualified under the DBE Program, the DBE owners must continue to demonstrate majority ownership, control of the firm's day-to-day operations, and direct and ongoing involvement in the firm's management. You must also continue to demonstrate direct involvement in contracts or projects awarded by MNUCP members, and which are subject to the MNUCP DBE Program.

Additionally, on an annual basis you will be required to file a No Change Affidavit, with supporting documentation. The No Change Affidavit indicates whether there are changes regarding the firm's size, gross receipts, ownership, work areas, and that your firm continues to meet the requirements of 49 C.F.R.
